Lake Oswego School District (LOSD) - Community Engagement

Randy Miller and John Wallin provided an overview of the Long Range Facilities Plan adopted by the LOSD on Monday February 10th.

A short video was presented documenting examples of deferred maintenance and seismic upgrades that must be addressed by the LOSD. It was reported the estimated cost to make necessary repairs and upgrades will be in excess of \$98,000,000 with almost half that amount for the seismic upgrades. That amount does not include certain costs that are known will be incurred.

The LOSD will propose a bond measure. As part of the process leading up to the bond measure the LOSD Board is, ". . . gathering community input, opinions and

priorities regarding the future of our educational programs and facility improvement planning."
